

MOTHER TERESA'S BIRTH DAY CELEBRATION:

On the auspicious occasion commemorating the birthday of 'Angle of Mercy' Mother Teresa's we have distributed cloths, blankets to poor and orphan and tricycles to handicapped. We also served with meals to poor and the deprived and distributed cakes. We

conducted free aid programs for the handicapped and Blinds. There was free food grain distribution to blind families in which we have provided a packet of rice, Dal and Refined Oil to each family and also have provided with Iron Shop for self mobile employment to the poor and blind family. Focus was given on self employment such Tailoring, Electronics. Computers, Communications, Information technology, Crafts, Arts, Handicrafts, Lathe works, Petty shops, Cafeteria, Starting Enterprises etc. occasion was graced by the local prominent dignitaries.





MOTHER TERESA CHILDRENS HOME:

Children home was sheltering to orphans, semi orphans, poor

children with 20 members, we provide hot foods, shelter, clothes, education, medical facility with and the avenues to get rid of such situations and commended our Trust's commitment towards community development that envisions healthy, vibrant, friendly,

We have taken up the task of distributing food grains, towels, blankets, food packets, fruits, some healthcare medicines and organized some recreational programs.

CARING THE AGED

Aging is time of multiple illnesses and general disability. Besides an increased leve1 of illness, the aging process itself leads certain disabilities



such as low vision and blindness resulting from cataracts, deafness resulting from nerve impairment, loss of mobility from arthritis and a general inability to care for oneself. Furthermore, aging is inevitable and thus of concern to each of us.

Our Trust is working in this direction in order to make a better living for the underprivileged people. We are promoting various social services and give enlightenment that special care is being taken for the welfare of the aged and provided information that would be of use to our elder citizens and also for the persons who care for them to bring a smile of peace to the innocent lives.



We are developing strategies to bring awareness among the community at large to make productive use of older persons

and to provide care to older persons in need, sensitizing children and youth towards older persons, organizing older persons themselves into coherent self help groups capable of articulating their rights and interests that the parents without any means to be supported by their children having sufficient means has been recognized by section 125 (1) (d) of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973, and Section 20(3) of the Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act, 1956.

EDUCATION:
